



### **SCREENINGS SAVE LIVES**

The COVID-19 pandemic has impacted recommended cancer screenings and cancer care.

- In the US, studies have found more than one third of adults failed to receive recommended cancer screenings during the pandemic.
- 43% of patients have missed routine preventive appointments due to COVID-19 fears.
- 35% of American adults had a cancer screening scheduled during the pandemic and missed it.
- An estimated 22 million cancer screenings were canceled or missed between March and June of 2020.
- One study found, at the initial peak of the pandemic in April 2020, screenings were lower for
  - Breast cancer by 85%
  - Colon cancer by 75%
  - Prostate cancer by 74%
  - Lung cancer by 56%
- Another study determined the number of cervical, colon and breast cancer screening tests dropped by more than 80% in the spring of 2020 due to concerns about COVID-19.



The earlier cancer is detected, the more treatment options are available and the better chances for survival.

# MEDICAL ONCOLOGY

Medical oncology focuses on the diagnosis and treatment of cancer. Innovative treatments including intravenous, oral medications and targeted therapies (non-chemotherapy drugs that are designed to treat specific tumor types) are used in addition to traditional chemotherapy. Phelps Health medical oncologists, nurses and staff coordinate a patient's treatment and therapy.

# RADIATION ONCOLOGY

Radiation oncology involves treating cancer with radiation. Radiation therapy uses targeted, high levels of energy or particles to kill cancer cells. Patients receiving radiation therapy often make daily trips to the cancer center to receive treatment. Phelps Health provides exceptional radiation therapy close to home, which alleviates the need for patients and their families to have to travel long distances during treatment.

- Avoid tobacco


Men who have any symptoms of prostate cancer should talk to their doctor or urologist about being screened.



- Secondhand smoke
- Family history of lung cancer
- Radiation therapy to the chest
- Exposure to radon or asbestos



#### Jennifer Gerlemann, BSN, RN Nurse Navigator

The nurse navigator offers patients and their families a single-point person to contact throughout their entire cancer journey and helps patients understand and navigate their diagnosis and treatment. The nurse navigator is one of the first contacts when patients find out they have been diagnosed with cancer and continues to offer support throughout the journey to help alleviate anxiety and improve the patient's sense of well-being.

#### Kevin McDonough, BS, CAC Patient Financial Access Representative


The financial counselor helps ease concerns about cost of the care and complexities of medical insurance by educating patients about their insurance benefits (e.g., deductible, out-of-pocket expense, co-insurance, co-pays, premiums, in- and out-of-network benefits), billing questions and options for payment plans.

#### Lorie Bourne, MS, RD, LD, CNSC Dietitian

The registered dietitian meets with patients to help with cancer treatment-related nutrition issues. Common issues the dietitian helps with are coping with weight loss, addressing poor appetite and taste changes, dealing with side effects of treatment, and providing education and support for patients with feeding tubes.

#### Susan Buhr, MSW, BSW Social Worker

The oncology social worker provides counseling to help reduce stress for cancer patients and their families. The oncology social worker helps patients access diagnosis and treatment information, cope with the cancer diagnosis, consider decisions about finding the best cancer care and more.
