



Visitor Policy

On April 3, in an effort to continue to protect our patients, staff and communities from the spread of COVID-19, we suspended all visitors at all of our locations. However, we realize in some cases, limited exceptions are needed.

Beginning tomorrow, Saturday, May 9, the following visitor policy will go into effect:

Hospital Inpatient Units—One visitor

Emergency Department—One visitor

Transitional Care Facility (TCF)—No visitors

COVID-19 Units (e.g., patients who have been tested for COVID-19)—No visitors

Patients under the Age of 18—One parent or guardian

Obstetrics/Labor and Delivery—One visitor

Intellectually Disabled Patients—One visitor or caregiver

Prisoners—One law enforcement officer

If the above criteria is met, please note the following guidelines:

- All visiting individuals must be adults (18 years or older).
- All visiting individuals will be required to complete a health screening for wellness (including checking for fever and respiratory symptoms) upon entry at Phelps Health.
- Individuals showing signs or symptoms of illness will not be allowed to visit.
- All visiting individuals will be required to wear a mask while at Phelps Health. If someone does not arrive wearing their own mask, one will be provided for them.
- Visitors will only be allowed during the hours of 10:00 AM to 7:00 PM.

In all other Phelps Health patient care areas, no visitors will be allowed. Limited exceptions will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
